<b>QUALIFICATION OVERVIEW</b>	
<i><b>Who is this qualification for and what could it lead to?</b></i>	<p>The Level 3 Award in Veterinary Leadership and Clinical Coaching aims to prepare and support learners for the role of leadership in the veterinary environment, supporting the education and training of student veterinary nurses in clinical practice.</p> <p>This Award allows learners to progress into further qualifications if they wish, including qualifications such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Workplace Assessor Courses</li> <li>• Level 3 Awards in Education and Training</li> <li>• Level 4 Certificate in Education and Training</li> <li>• Level 5 Diploma in Education and Training</li> </ul>
<i><b>Are there any entry requirements?</b></i>	<p>Learners should be a qualified registered veterinary nurse (RVN) on the small animal or equine RCVS register.</p> <p>Learners should have a minimum of 1-year post-registration experience in clinical veterinary practice.</p>
<i><b>What are the key purposes of the qualification?</b></i>	<p>The key purposes of the qualification are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To give the learners the opportunity to gain the knowledge and skills necessary to execute their role as a Veterinary Leader optimally, and provide high quality support to student veterinary nurses.</li> <li>• To enable the learners to develop a deeper understanding of leadership in veterinary practice and how to support the wellbeing of staff.</li> </ul>
<i><b>What does this qualification cover?</b></i>	<p>The programme will predominately be theoretical teaching however the learner will be expected to reflect upon practical elements of veterinary leadership.</p> <p>In order to successfully achieve the qualification a learner will need to gain a pass in all units within the syllabus. All units are mandatory.</p>

<b>How is the qualification assessed?</b>	<p><b>Knowledge and understanding will be assessed by:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Multiple choice examination set and administered by Central Qualifications</li> <li>• Assignments set and administered by Central Qualifications</li> </ul>
